With kindlier hand, our trials face.

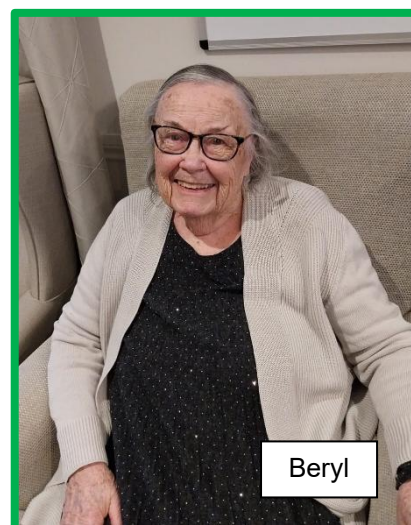
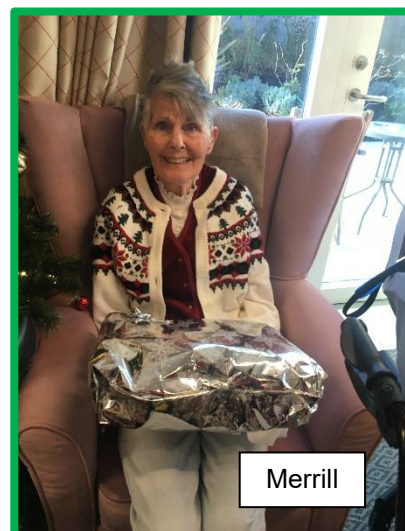
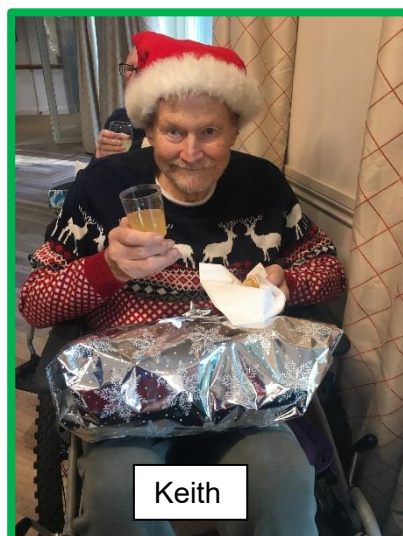
